Bedroom

- Twin XL bedding – 2 sets, different colors

- Clothes hangers (24)
- Desk lamp

Bathroom

- 2 sets of bath towels + washcloths
 - all the same color
- Grooming + hygiene supplies
 - Feminine products
 - Shaving supplies
 - Deodorant (3x)
- Toothbrush + case/holder
- Toothpaste
- 1 box of tissue
- 2 (4pk.) toilet paper

Clothes and Accessories

- 4-5 pants + 4 shorts
- 6-8 shirts/t-shirts
- 10 undergarments (socks, etc.)
- 4-5 sweatshirts/sweaters
- 2-3 gym/workout clothes
- 1-2 sleepwear
- Swim wear
- 2-3 casual shoes/sandals
- 1-2 athletic shoes
- Dressy outfit
- Winter coat, mittens/gloves, scarf, hat, boots (may be brought to Family Weekend October 5)
- Rain jacket and umbrella

Technology

- Cell phone (ideally smart phone)

Personal Health

- Thermometer

Laundry Supplies

- Detergent (pods are recommended)
- Dryer sheets
- Stain spray
- 1-2 microfiber cloths
- Small container or coin purse

Optional

- Alarm clock
- Fan (box or standing)
- White noise machine
- Fitness tracker

1 per apartment – coordinate with roommates:

- TV / stand
- VCR / DVD player
- Radio / Stereo
- Convection oven / Pizza oven
- Coffee maker
- Gaming system (1 per student)



Career Program Clothing

One key to success in preparing for, finding, and keeping a job is looking the part by having appropriate clothing for any work situation. To ensure MICC students are prepared in this area, the following list of clothing items are all required for incoming students. All clothing must fit well and be in very good condition (no stains, rips, pilling, etc.).

First-Year Students

- 2-3 pairs of business casual pants, includes khakis, “Dockers” and dark blue or black jeans (**dark wash only**, no embellishments or light wash, no leggings)
- 2-3 business casual tops, includes polo shirts, button downs (no sweatshirts or t-shirts)
- Casual dress shoes, comfortable style but not sneakers
- Dress socks (to match pants)
- Leather belt (coordinate with pants)
