Career Program Clothing

One key to success in preparing for, finding, and keeping a job is looking the part by having appropriate clothing for any work situation. To ensure MICC students are prepared in this area, the following list of clothing items are all required for incoming students. All clothing must fit well and be in very good condition (no stains, rips, pilling, etc.). Students may need to purchase additional clothing upon job hire that fits the employer's dress code.

First Year Students

- 2-3 pairs of business casual pants, includes khakis, "Dockers" and dark blue or black jeans (**dark wash only**, no embellishments or light wash), skirts or dresses
- 2-3 business casual tops, includes polo shirts, button downs, sweaters (no sweatshirts or t-shirts)
- Casual dress shoes, comfortable style but not sneakers
- Dress socks (to match pants)

COVID-19 Packing List

This list is intended to supplement the College Packing List provided to all College participants. Included are key tools and personal supplies to support symptom monitoring and heightened health/hygiene requirements.

- 7-10 reusable face masks or 2-3 packs of disposable face masks
- Hand sanitizer
- Disinfectant wipes
- Over-the-counter medications for symptom management
 - Cough medicine
 - Pain relievers
 - Fever reducers
 - Decongestants
- Laptop, for distance learning if participants needs to be temporarily quarantined
- Personal temperature thermometer
- Gloves, as desired
- Reusable water bottle, or other preferred hydrating beverage
- Personal fidgets, to minimize shared fidgets on-campus
